
The report contains information regarding your child's progress. It details the Curriculum for Excellence **level** they have most recently **achieved** and then the **progress within the next level** at which they are working.

There are three progress stages within each level, **Emerging, Enhancing** and **Extending**. A more detailed description of these is attached. These progress levels are a new approach across Perth & Kinross schools. You will also see ratings for effort, behaviour and homework.

We are still working to agree and moderate these levels and stages with our primary colleagues therefore there may be some anomalies between their levels from P7 and this year's levels so if there are differences, please don't be alarmed.

### Curriculum for Excellence Levels

The following is a guide to help you understand the **levels** of progression in your child's report. Levels and comments are indicated for each of the subject areas. In compiling this report the teachers will have considered the breadth of learning, the level of challenge and the ability to use skills and knowledge in different contexts.
