S1-3

- Live & Online* activities with the teacher for around half of the class time allocated for each subject, each week.
- Teachers will notify learners how and when they will be Live & Online.
- Learners will have other tasks to do which equate to the number of periods they have weekly for each subject.



S4-6

- Senior Phase classes follow the school timetable with teachers being 'live and online'
- When the teacher is holding live lessons or live catch-ups, these will be created as a meeting in the Teams calendar in advance, live chat in the Team channel will be advertised in advance.



TEACHER - LEARNER COMMUNICATION



- Take part in live sessions, don't be afraid to ask and answer questions.
- If you want to ask a question outside class time, do email your teacher but remember to try to stick to school hours, they will reply but don't expect an immediate response.
- As when in school, follow teacher instructions and don't disrupt the class.
