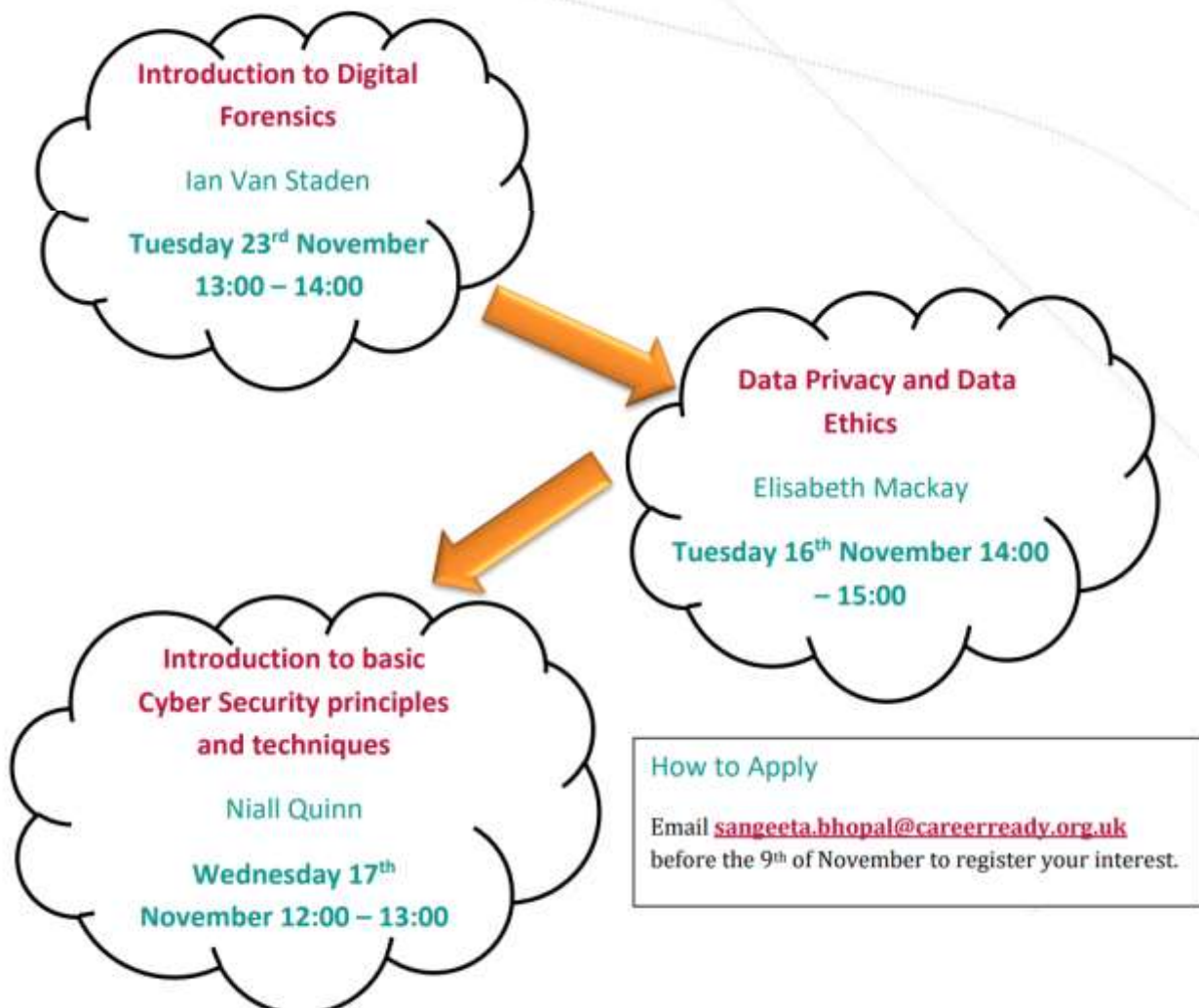
### S5/6 Digital Masterclasses
