Gateway to Medicine is an alternative entry route for S5 students who might not achieve the grades necessary in August to apply for medicine in S6. Successful applicants will join the University of St Andrews as a student in September 2021, instead of progressing onto S6 at school. Gateway to Medicine students will study modules in Biology, Chemistry, and one other subject of their choosing. They will also receive additional support throughout the year, including:

- A week of Hospital-based work experience
- Access team support contact and academic advisor
- UCAT and MMI support sessions
- Biology and Chemistry tutoring
- Introductory Medicine lectures
- Gateway to Medicine Scholarship (if eligible)

Upon successful completion of the Gateway to Medicine year, students will progress onto the A100 Medicine Degree with St Andrews.
